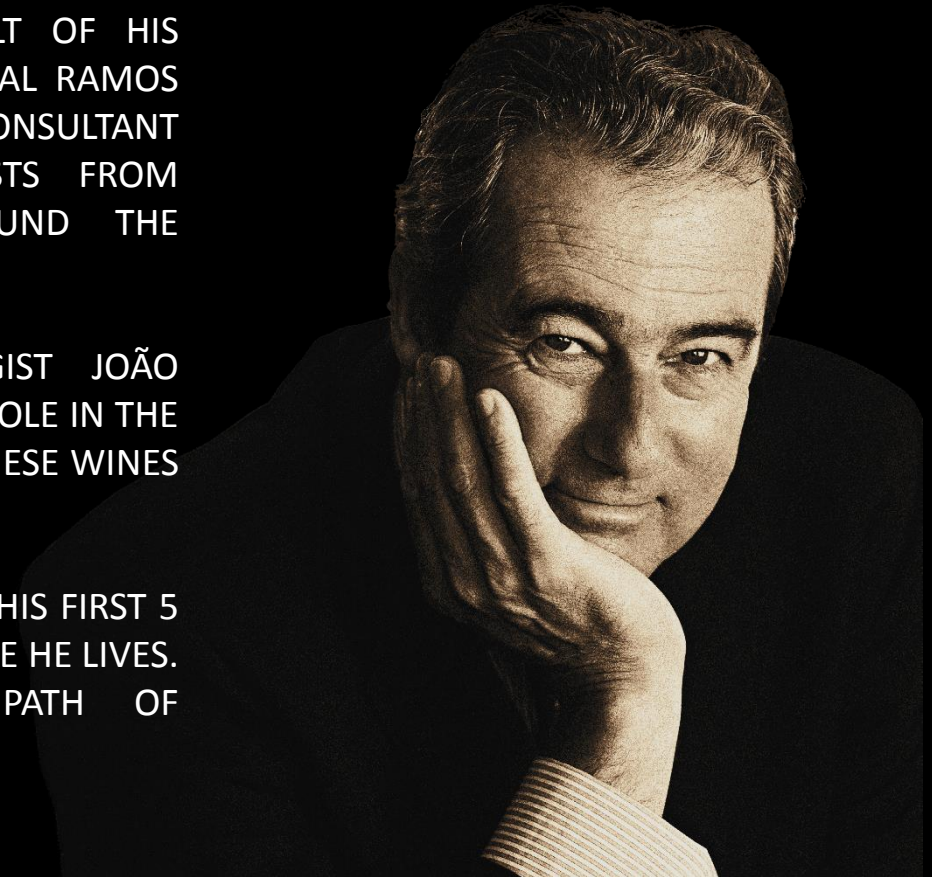

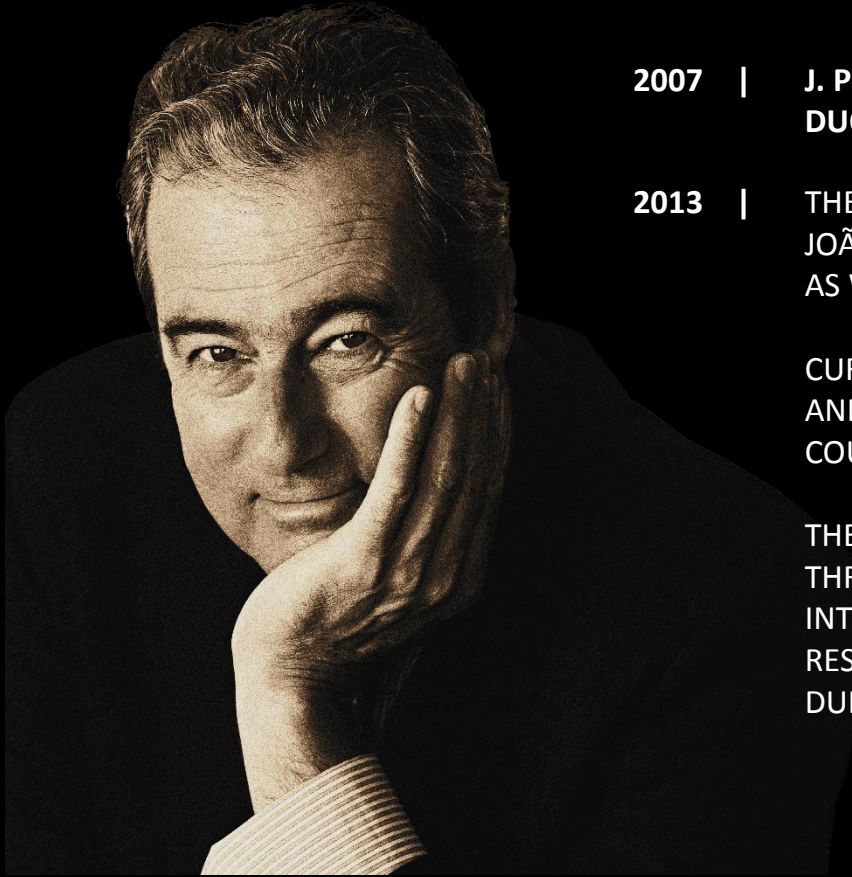

QUINTA FOZ DE AROUCE IS LOCATED IN LOUSÃ, IN BEIRAS REGION. THE RIVERS AROUCE AND CEIRA RUN THROUGH THE ESTATE, WHICH IS ALSO SURROUNDED BY THE THE MOUNTAINS OF LOUSÃ AND PENELA.

IT IS OWNED BY THE COUNT OF FOZ DE AROUCE, JOÃO PORTUGAL RAMOS' FATHER-IN-LAW. THE ANCIENTS DOCUMENTS KEPT AT QUINTA DE FOZ DE AROUCE REFER THAT THE ESTATE BELONGS TO THIS FAMILY SINCE THE 18TH CENTURY, BUT IT IS ALSO KNOWN THAT SOME CONSTRUCTIONS ARE OLDER, BECAUSE THE ORIGINAL HOUSE HAS BEEN DESTROYED TWICE BY FIRE. THE CHAPEL NEAR THE HOUSE WAS FOUNDED BY THE POPE BENEDICT XIII IN AUGUST 28TH 1724.

THE ESTATE HAS 60 HECTARES, BUT ONLY 15 HECTARES HAVE VINEYARDS, 3 OF THEM ARE OVER 70 YEARS OLD – THE VINES OF STA. MARIA.

## A NEW CHALLENGE

JOÃO RAMOS ALWAYS DREAMT PRODUCING WINE IN VINHO VERDE REGION AND THIS IS THE MOST RECENT PROJECT OF THE GROUP.

LIMA IS NAMED AFTER THE LEGENDARY LIMA RIVER THAT CROSSES THE REGION. DURING ROMAN TIMES, INVADING SOLDERS AVOIDED THIS RIVER AS IT WAS SAID TO BE THE INCARNATION OF HADES' MEMORY-ERASING LETHE. TODAY, VINES FLOURISH ALONG THE BANKS, AND LOUREIRO IS ONE OF THE MOST EMBLEMATIC GRAPE VARIETIES OF THIS REGION.

THE SINGLE VARIETY WINE ALVARINHO IS PRODUCED IN THE SUB-REGION OF MONÇÃO & MELGAÇO. THIS IS JOÃO RAMOS FAVOURITE WHITE VARIETY AND PRODUCING IT IN ITS NATIVE REGION IS A DREAM COME TRUE.

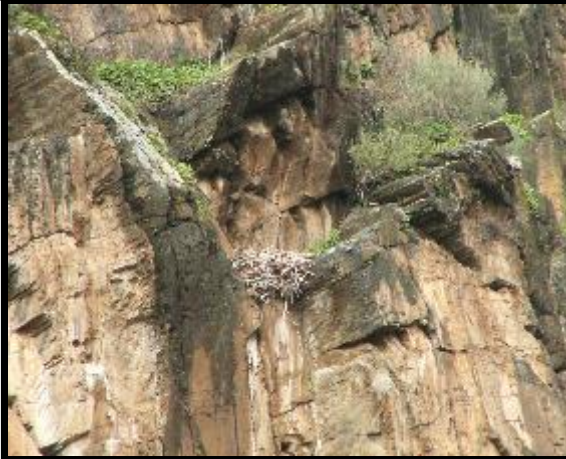

Fermentation takes place at controlled temperature of 16º C, for two to three weeks. 20% is fermented in new French oak barrels.
